QUALIFICATION RECOGNITION



Cambridge International AS & A Levels are recognised by UCAS and universities in the UK and overseas as equivalent, grade for grade, with UK AS and A Levels.

- Cambridge International AS Levels have half the content of the corresponding Cambridge International A Level and may be completed in one year.
- There is no A* grade awarded at Cambridge International AS Level.
