

COURSE OVERVIEW

- This is the final year High School course for students in the Cambridge A level programme. They will take the same 4 A Level subjects in Year 12 (subject to a passing grade in their Year 11).
- The course will prepare students to complete the A Level content before they take their Cambridge exams in the last quarter. The final result for each of the 4 subjects will be combined with their AS Level Cambridge results.

Develop a clear understanding of, and acquire, the knowledge and skills outlined in the assessment objectives for each respective Cambridge GCE A Level subject.

Register and sit for the Cambridge GCE A-Level examinations in Year 12.
