

COURSE OVERVIEW

Programme Duration

Cambridge IGCSE is a two-year programme where students are assessed at the end of the two years in Year 10 by Cambridge.

Academic Requirements

This is an academic programme which requires students to have a good understanding of Math and Science in lower secondary with strong English language skills such as reading, writing, speaking and listening.

Subject Commitment

Students are required to take 6 Cambridge IGCSE subjects for a period of 2 consecutive years.

Language of Instruction

The course is conducted in English, and all textbooks and assessments are written in the English language which students must be competent.

OBJECTIVES

1

Gain familiarity with the Cambridge IGCSE curriculum and the assessment objectives for the subjects covered.

Develop a clear understanding of, and acquire, the knowledge and skills outlined in the assessment objectives for each respective Cambridge IGCSE subject.

Register and sit for the Cambridge IGCSE examinations in Year 10.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To local polytechnics in Singapore for Diploma courses

- English Proficiency: You must have taken IGCSE English as a First Language. Second Language results are generally not accepted for meeting the core English requirement.
- Mathematics and Science
- Two best remaining subjects—with the caveat that no subject may be double-counted across categories.

COURSE STRUCTURE

Student MUST do 6 subjects comprise (4 compulsory subjects & 2 non-compulsory subjects)

Mandatory subject

IGCSE First Language English	IGCSE First Language Chinese
IGCSE Mathematics	IGCSE Physics

Students are required to select only TWO (2) of the following elective subjects:

Accounting or Additional Mathematics*

Chemistry or Computer Science*

*Choose **ONE** subject **ONLY**
